TEAMS:

Every vehicle is considered a team. Every team must have at least two (2) people (driver and navigator). If you have more than four people on your team, there is a \$25 registration fee for each additional person. For safety reasons, motorcycle teams are not permitted.

This is an adult only event and the team driver must be at least 21 years of age and present a valid driver's license. Proof of insurance and car ownership (or permission of owner) are also required at registration.

Bonus prizes will also be awarded at check-points along the course.

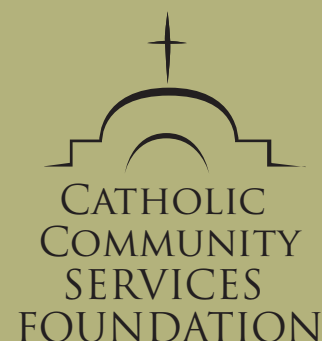
CCS helps children, families, elders and people with disabilities without regard to age, gender, race, or religion.
